Dear Friends at St. David’s,

On the weekend of July 23-24, 2016, the congregation graciously voted to call me to be your pastor, and on Monday, October 10th, I had my first day in the office. Since then, I’ve been performing the pastoral duties of the church and getting to know the people and ministry at St. David’s. However, I still haven’t yet been officially “installed” into the position.

In many ways, in this time between my being elected and being officially installed, I’ve been serving as your “Pastor-Elect.” And in this transition time, my family and I have moved into a white house (the parsonage of Ascension Lutheran in Franklin Square), I have been busy filling up my cabinet (with files and books), and I’ve been engaged in a “listening tour” to start imagining future possibilities for our life together.

But the time has come to make it official. So on **Sunday, February 12th at 3:00 p.m.**, we’ll be having a special worship service for the “Installation of a Pastor” - which formally ritualizes and celebrates the beginning of a ministry and a relationship between a congregation and their newly called pastor (Please mark your calendars, because I’m pretty sure there won’t be a count-down clock for this on CNN). Then, following the service, there will be a light reception downstairs celebrating this new beginning (a kind of inaugural ball).

I hope you can make it as we make it official, and I’m excited to see where God will lead us and what God will accomplish through us in the years to come.
