Announcing St. David's Work Day, Saturday, October 1st. St. David's has been called to provide volunteers for new house construction. Join the St. David's crew! Our July 9th work day was so inspiring we wanted others to have a chance to feel the joy and deep satisfaction of the day, working to move a family out of poverty. You are needed. No prior construction experience is needed, just a good attitude! (Pre-registration required.) Habitat helps the working poor move into home ownership (and a mortgage) through leveraging good will in accessing land, materials, and labor from individuals, churches, and business. We will begin the day at 8:45 am. (please bring your lunch) Water will be provided. We'll end the day at 2:30pm. Habitat Suffolk will provide competent guidance and oversight, and all safety equipment and tools. Parsonage Study Continues

Pastor Stumme will be commuting from Queens to start his ministry among us in October. Our council has been considering how his family can eventually move closer, as the family desires, given the level of housing allowance we provide him. Our Council has concluded that the local cost of housing in and around Massapequa, whether rented or purchased, is now so high that some pastors cannot afford to rent or buy here. The property committee is charged with

examining in detail the design, costs and logistics of building a parsonage on our land at the end of our parking lot. The benefit is not only to have our future pastors close to us, but to leverage and grow the value of our campus. (A house instantly increases the value of our idle land, greater than the cost of construction.) The finance committee is examining our financing options, and a campaign committee will lead the promotion. At present, multiple architects are being interviewed for consideration. Along the way, the council will communicate their findings to you in person after designated worship services, and will ask for your feedback and ideas. Of course, when the entire project proposal is conceptually strong, your congregational approval is required before it can start. Hopefully, such a decision can be made by January 2017. to stop or change your offering at any time. If you have any questions, just ask Treasurer Anne Anderson or Pastor.

Sunday School & Kid's Church

What do kids do in Sunday School at St. David's? We start with Kid's Church, a short age appropriate worship service in the old nave. Little ones sit in the front row and look at the candles with awe, they join in the songs and clap their hands—their faith journey is underway. Each week, Pastor Arden talks to the kids and gives them a message. Pastor Micah will be continuing this tradition. The kids light and extinguish the candles, and collect the offering. The voices of the older kids lead the Lord's Prayer and the younger ones join in. By 9:20 AM, we are energized for Christ and heading to our classrooms. The kids are divided into three classes by age: preschool (age 2-4); primary (grade K-2); and secondary (grade 3-5). We follow a lectionary based curriculum. That means the lesson taught in class is from one of the readings parents hear during worship in the big church each week. It makes it easy for parents to talk to kids about what they learned.

It's not too late to register your child to join us at Sunday School this year!
